

TWO FUTURE JUDGMENTS OF THE WICKED

**THE WICKED NATIONS
OF MATT. 25:31-46**

COMPARED TO

**THE WICKED DEAD
OF REV. 20:11-15**

WHY THESE GROUPS ARE NOT THE SAME

<u>Difference:</u>	<u>Wicked Nations; Matt. 25</u>	<u>Wicked Dead; Rev. 20</u>
1. Place of Judgment:	They appear before Christ as He sits on the throne of His glory after the Tribulation (at the beginning of the Millennium).	They appear before Christ as He sits on the Great White Throne after the Millennium.
2. Identification of those judged:	Individuals, identified by national origin.	Identified only as individuals.
3. Condition of those judged:	Are living on earth after the Tribulation (at the beginning of the Millennium).	Are raised from the dead to be judged after the Millennium.
4. What they are to be judged for:	Judged according to their treatment of Jews during the Tribulation (The King's brethren are the Jews).	Judged according to their works as recorded in books (books recording their works and the Book of life are opened).
5. Classification of those judged:	Three classes are named: sheep (righteous Gentiles), goats (unrighteous Gentiles), brethren (righteous Israelites).	Only one class is recognized, the wicked dead (those whose names are not written in the Book of Life).
6. Location of the judgment:	On the earth, before Christ in the land of Israel.	Before Christ, at an uncertain location.
7. The result of the judgment:	Some enter the Millennial Kingdom (sheep) and some go into the Lake of Fire (goats).	All will enter into the Lake of Fire.
8. Where they came from:	They are Gentiles from all over the earth who survived the Tribulation.	Those who died in unbelief from all of the generations that have lived on earth from the time of creation until the end of the Millennium.
