

# The Timeline of Jesus Christ's Death, Burial, and Resurrection

Jewish time is figured as a 24-hour day from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Lev. 23:32) in contrast to our modern time which uses a 12:00 midnight to 12:00 midnight timeframe.

Passover was celebrated on the fourteenth day of the first month of the Jewish year (Ex. 12:1-6 ff.). This month was referred to as Abib in Israel's early years (Ex. 13:3-5; 23:15; 34:18; Deut. 16:1). But, after the Babylonian captivity it came to be known as Nisan (Esth. 3:7; cf. Neh. 2:1).
