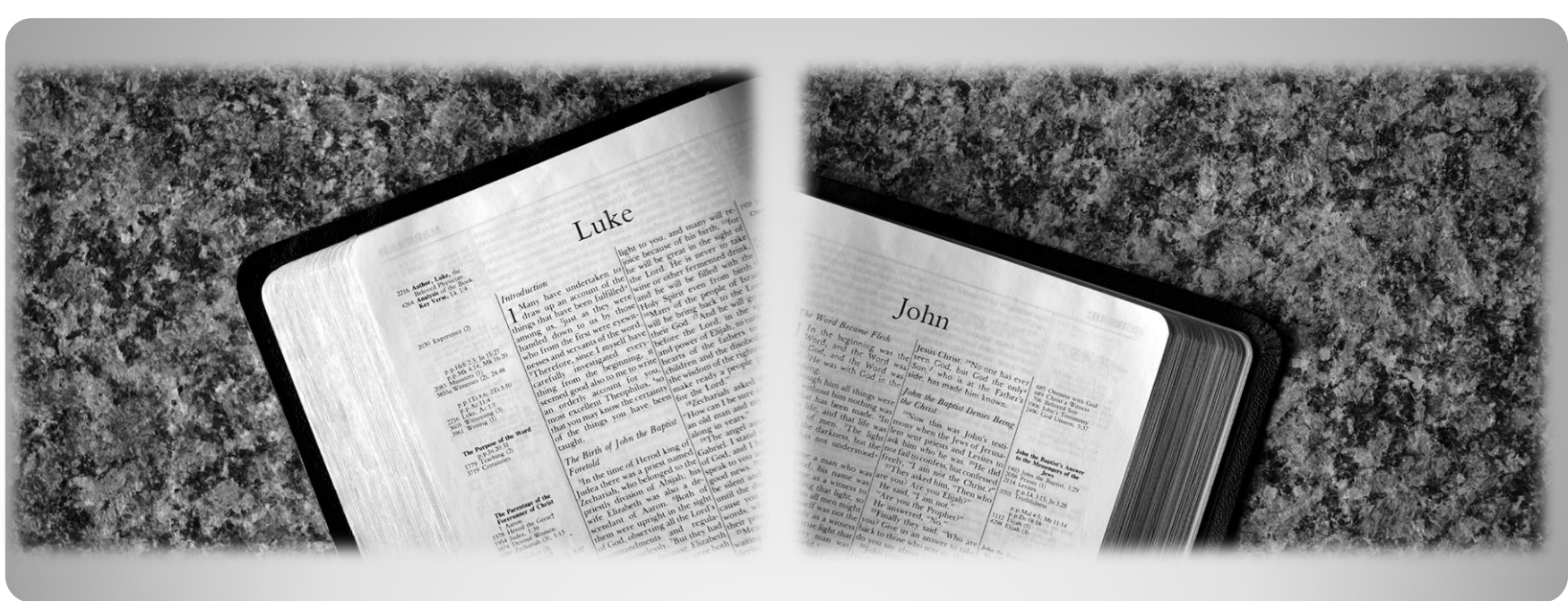

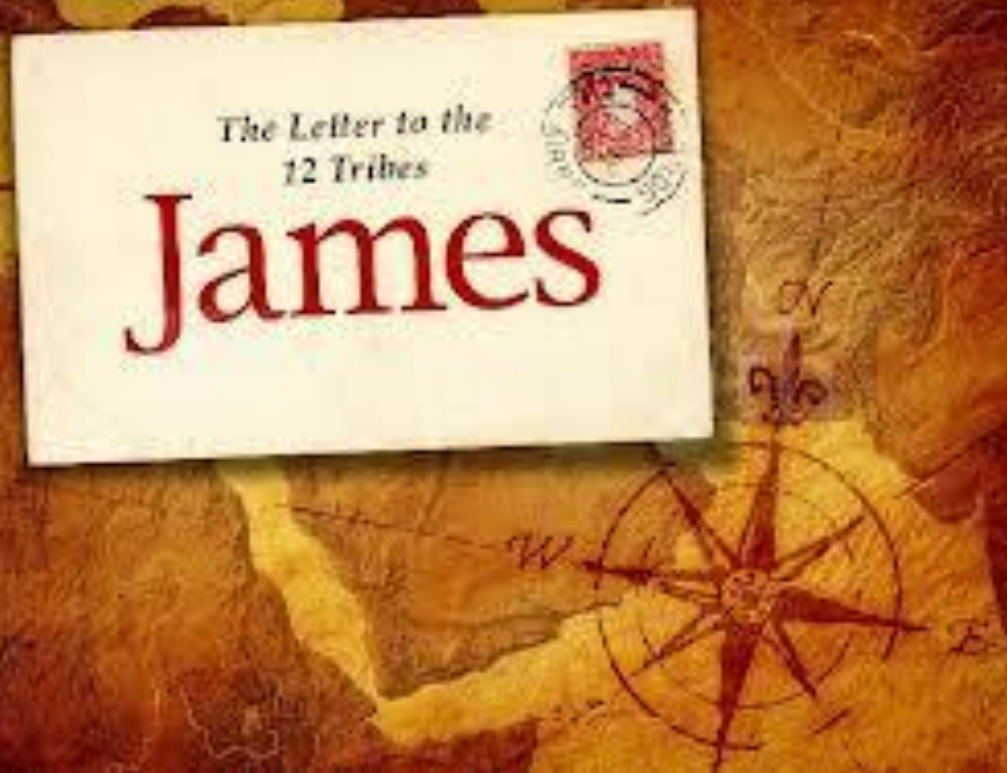

“James, a servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ, to the twelve tribes which are scattered abroad” (1:1).

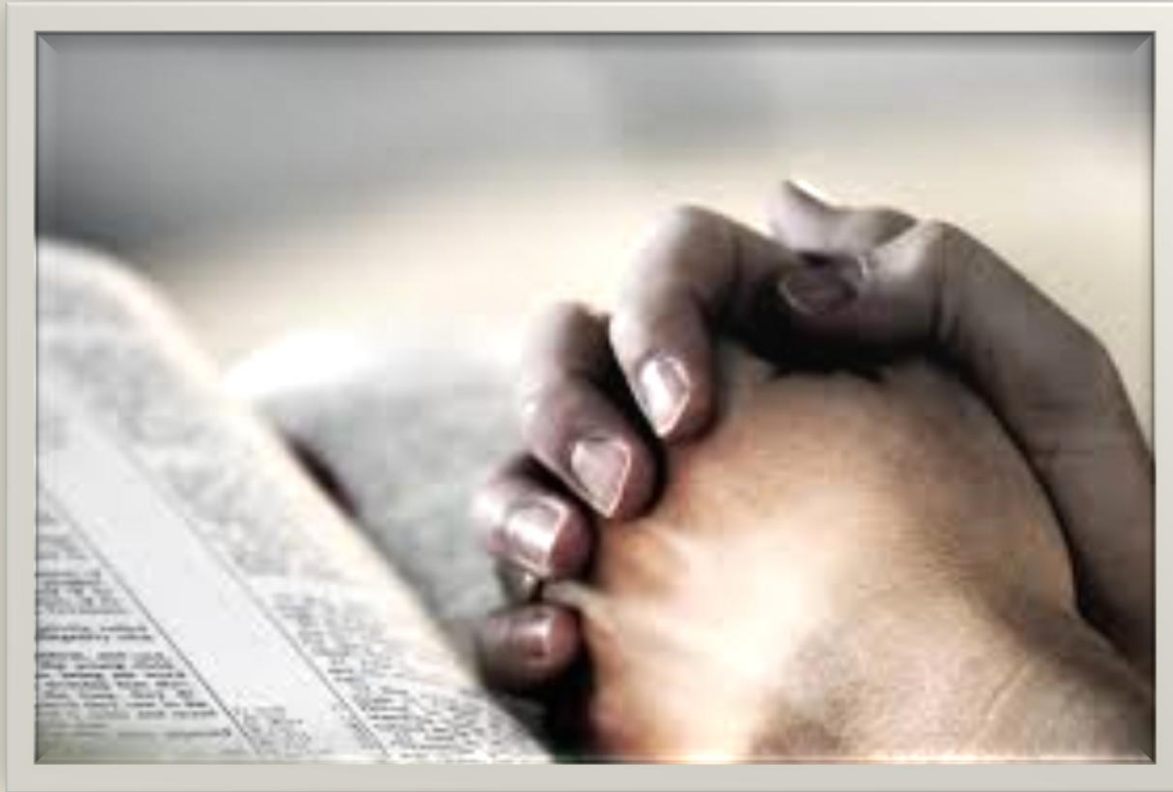

Under grace, we are to “Be careful for nothing, but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God...”

And not whatsoever ye ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive!

Instead “...and the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus” (Phil. 4:6,7).

Under grace, we pray knowing “we have boldness and access with confidence by the [faithfulness] of [Christ” (Eph. 3:12).

Under grace, we pray knowing God always wants us to turn to Him in prayer, and to “pray without ceasing” (I Thes. 5:17).

Under grace we pray knowing God is “able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think” (Eph. 3:20), according to His perfect will.



In Romans 8:22, we see that the “whole creation groaneth.”
